My wife and I have been impressed with the enthusiasm and cooperation shown by the participants. All the novices listened well to the instructions and most of you carried them out well.

Now that the season is underway I have just a few items to point out so everyone will have a better understanding.

1. ALL NOVICE and ARR drivers must report to the license Director prior to going out for practice.

2. Any ARR driver who may be upgraded to IRR should pick out a senior number and ask for it to be held. If this isn't done then one will be given at random.

3. Have your cars ready for racing when you go to tech. The tech line is not the place for getting your car race ready. Also there is no need to put an "N" across the day-glo panel.

4. All participants in the NOVICE program are responsible for themselves, their cars and crews. If you have any questions or misunderstanding please contact me and I will try to work with all involved. The Novice program is a learning process to LOOK, LEARN and LISTEN.

5. Infractions ran rather high at SIR and because of the track conditions some were overlooked for now. Under no condition shall anyone pass under a yellow flag - standing or waving. Also observe and acknowledge the flags.

6. The NOVICE Drivers meeting is MANDATORY for all participating in the Novice program.

A super thanks to all the Senior observers at SIR for going out in the rain and doing such a fantastic job. With out such observers there would be no need for the Novice races.
