## FROM THE RACE STEWARD, MARY ANN HUTTON

Summer-like sunshine graced PIR April 18/19. With many new personnel and troublesome communications, Saturday got off to a slow start but by Sunday most of the details fell into place for the Cascade Club. The scales became inoperable Sunday afternoon, however, preventing the intended weighing of cars after races.

Car #757, having finished first in G Production, was protested by car #571 for failing to have a passenger seat in the car. The protest was found valid, the lack of a passenger seat being in violation of production modification rules (Comp. Reg. 1402), and car #757 was disqualified.

The April 25/26 SIR races also had a good field of cars and mild, clear weather. Some extremely competitive racing was enjoyed by a significant spectator crowd, thanks to local radio advertisements. The Formula Vee race provided a three car photo-finish for second place after an extremely close race with continuous position changes in the three-car draft.

Race Group 5 also had a particularly large and competitive grid with five Formula Atlantics, one Formula B and 25 Formula Fords. Two incidents marked the race. In the outside position in Turn 8, car #517X got loose, causing contact with car #419X on the inside of the turn. Car #419X sustained minor front suspension damage. Car #517X continued off course on the outside of Turn 8, hitting a barrel and sustaining front end damage. Both cars retired from the race.

Later in the race car #72 drafted inside car #14 entering Turn 2 in traffic. Car #72 spun, causing car #14 to attempt evasive action. Colliding with #72, car #14 was launched, hitting the tire wall at high speed. Car #72 sustained some corner damage. Car #14 sustained heavy damage to the body, suspension, chassis and components. Neither driver was injured. The tire wall at this location was a recent addition by IRDC and apparently worked well in absorbing the impact of this crash.

First and second place finishers were weighed in Formula Vee, 440, D Production and Formula Ford. All were found to be of legal weight. Cars will continue to be weighed throughout the season, with Assistant Steward Hank Gerber in charge of assembling production car weights and conducting the weigh-ins.
