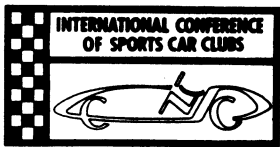

The first five Formula Fords were weighed after their race. Of the five, only Car #4ow weighed in at a legal weight, with the other four registering underweight to varying degrees. I did not impose disqualification or other penalties, however, based on consideration of three combined factors. First, after conferring with those who conducted the weigh-in I learned that not all the cars had been impounded directly from the track, as they should be, but most had returned to their pits first. Second, while checked throughout the weekend and apparently functioning properly, the scales had not been recently certified. Third, in re-weighing one of the cars, the scales registered it at a different weight than the first time. In sum, the repeatability and general reliability of the scales and circumstances were too uncertain on which to base official action. No protests were lodged by any other drivers.

FALL MEETINGS AND AWARDS BANQUET - NOV 14/15

SUPPLEMENTAL REGULATIONS: Infractions will result in disciplinary action against the driver at this race!!!!

1. Only vehicles eligible under ICSCC or SCCA racing regulations are eligible to compete. This includes all Sports Racing Cars, Sedans, Formula Cars and Production Cars.
2. There will be RESERVED PARKING area west of the concession stand for scoring, timing, turn workers. Passes available through workers registration.
3. NO ANIMALS are permitted in the paddock area.
4. NO OPEN ALCOHOLIC beverages are allowed in the paddock area until the track is closed for the day. Illegal drugs are not allowed at any time.
5. No vehicles, drivers or crews will be allowed into the track area without displaying the appropriate passes at the entrance to the track.
6. Registration closes at 2:00 pm Saturday and 10:00 am Sunday. NO PIT PASSES will be available after these hours.
7. Competition numbers must be readable from the scoring tower, RAIN OR SHINE. Section 1106 strictly enforced.
8. Racers will receive two vehicle passes: race car and support car.
9. There is NO SCRUBBING OF TIRES! THIS WILL BE ENFORCED!!
10. Late entries will be handled according to ICSCC rules.
11. Spectators' passes to the paddock area will be \$5.00 at the gate.
12. DRIVERS SERVICES: This is located in the Rose Cup Room at the west end of the Blitz Tower.
13. The racing pits are off limits to persons 16 years and younger. This will be enforced.
14. No racing engines may be turned on before 9:00 am, EXCEPT: Race Group 3, Formula Vee and 440. These cars will be allowed to warm their engines quietly after 8:45 am.
15. The P.I.R. scale is certified and will be official. It will be available during Tech and after each race group.
16. There will be no SPECTATORS, DRIVERS OR CREWS beyond the barricades on the gravel road. This could be grounds for disqualification!!!
17. No bicycles at the track.
