#### RACE STEWARD'S REPORT: VICTORIA, JULY 25/26

The track, the weather and the dr.vers were all in fine form for the second semi-annual-maybe-almost-last race at Victoria Motor Speedway July 25/26.

There were some tremendous races in many classes and several outstanding performances. All 80+ drivers are to be especially commended for their passing and allowing others to pass during the afternoon's races which allowed for the good racing by all on this tight, demanding track.

The afternoon's racing conditions were especially right for seven drivers who broke Victoria lap records in their class during their race: Ron Householder, FA, 33.14 (overall lap record); Mike Powers, AIP, 39.11; John Aitken, FIP, 39.70; Tim Moore, DP, 39.78; Larry Bangert, FV, 39.86; Steve May FP, 42.86; Mike Cox, GIP, 45.84.

However, two vehicles succumbed to the hazards of the Victoria track. In a Sunday qualifying session, No. 299 c/w got a bit loose and in correcting caught the hole on the inside of Turn 4, resulting in a multiple roll-over and roof landing. The car sustained significant damage but the safety systems worked, including hefty roll bar and mounting plates and the driver escaped unhurt. In Race 4, No. 72c/w met the fence in Turn 4 after a possible flat. The sports racer was heavily damaged but the driver unharmed.

Other racing incidents included body contact in Race 2 between No. 46c/w and 124c/w in Turn 1, caused by brake fade by No. 124 and resulting in a flat tire for No. 46. In Race 3, racing contact occurred between No. 168c/w and No. 78c/w on the oval. In Race 4, No. 126c/w tapped No. 257c/w in Turn 1. In the first lap of Race 5, No. 10/w nosed No. 810/w into the first turn. All cars continued on after these minor incidents.

The future for races at the Victoria track still remains uncertain. The RV park has been designed and constructed preserving all of the track after original development plans called for bulldozing over portions of the track. With the pavement at least saved, its future use is still a possibility and is now under negotiation by the VMSC.

#### PROTEST INFORMATION

A protest was filed at PIR, July 12, 1981, against No. 35 c/w (G Production) by Nos. 6, 89 and 128c/w, questioning legal weight, wheel size, tire size and locked rear end or limited slip. The car was found to be of legal weight and not having a locked rear end or limited slip. However, the car was found to have wheels exceeding the maximum allowed in violation of Comp. Reg. 1402B (5). Under Comp. Reg. 1402B (7), the tire size run would be allowed on the wheel size used, but would not be allowed on the maximum wheel size allowed for the car. As a result of the protest and findings, No. 35c/w was disqualified for the mechanical infraction.

- 1. Westwood Tower is out of bounds to all competitors and crews.
- 2. Race Results will be posted on the Bulletin Board at the Driver Services Building, in the paddock.
- 3. Drivers requiring Race Results must give their name and address in writing to the Competition Chairman before the first race,
- 4. Maximum Speed in the paddock is 5 MPH.
- 5. Gasoline in the Pit or Paddock Areas must be in approved containers.
- 6. NO SMOKING in the Racing Pits or along the fence of the paddock.
- 7. A maximum of 4 people (including the driver if out of the car) will be allowed in the Racing pit area.
- 8. Following a pit stop, a driver shall check with the starter for any signals being displayed, before entering the circuit.
- 9. On the Back Straight, keep to the left and pass on the right.
- 10. Emergency Vehicles will generally travel on the left side of the track.

# SUPPLEMENTAL REGULATIONS: Infractions will result in disciplinary action against the driver at this race!!!

- 1. Only vehicles eligible under ICSCC or SCCA racing regulations are eligible to compete. This includes all Sports Racing Cars, Sedans, Formula Cars and Production Cars.
- 2. There will be RESERVED PARKING area west of the concession stand for scoring, timing turn workers. Passes available through workers registration.
- 3. NO ANIMALS are permitted in the paddock area.
- 4. NO OPEN ALCOHOLIC beverages are allowed in the paddock area until the track is closed for the day. Illegal drugs are not allowed at any time.
- 5. No vehicles, drivers or crews will be allowed into the track area without displaying the appropriate passes at the entrance to the track.
- 6. Registration closes at 2:00 pm Saturday and 10:00 am Sunday. NO PIT PASSES will be available after these hours.
- 7. Competition numbers must be readable from the scoring tower, RAIN OR SHINE. Section 1106 strictly enforced.
- 8. There is NO SCRUBBING OF TIRES! THIS WILL BE ENFORCED!!!
- 9. Late entries will be handled according to ICSCC rules.
- 10. Spectators' passes to the paddock area will be \$4.00 at the gate.
