MINUTES OF TELEPHONE MEETING - APRIL 8/9, 1982

On March 30th John Hector of the Oregon DEQ notified I.C.S.C.C. of the possibility that Formula V's could be except from the muffler regulations the Department is preparing.

I.C.S.C.C. Competition Regulation 1112 requires mufflers on all vehicles. A telephone poll of Executive Board Representatives April 8 and 9 decided unanimously that Formula V's racing in Conference would not be required to have the prescribed mufflers pending DEQ decision.
