FROM THE PRESIDENT, BILL ROOT

The 1982 race season is underway and although the entries are down, the quality is up. Entries at both events were about 30% less than in recent years.

At SIR the weather Saturday was changeable. The workers were out in rain and hail! Sunday was improved with the sun contributing to the first race of the season. There were several on-course problems with a spectacular rollover between turns 2 and 3 which triggered another off-course rollover. Both drivers were OK but the production race was red-flagged to clear the debris. The race was restarted in single file. Just a note - the formula race was good, fast and clean.

The following weekend at Portland driving was better with fewer problems; possibly due to drivers getting back into the groove or maybe due to the beautiful weather.

The Oregon DEQ has given a tentative deviation to the muffler rule for Formula Vee's. The Executive Board has agreed that, until further notice, Formula Vee's in Conference are exempt from the muffler requirement. A reminder that all cars must comply with the 105 db maximum.

Victoria Motor Sports Club has lost Western Speedway for racing. To those of us who have raced there, this is a real loss. The racing and hospitality at Victoria were outstanding! At an Executive Board meeting at Portland, SCCBC petitioned and it was approved that the June 5/6 race be at Westwood. The August 7/8 date has been cancelled. This leaves a 12 race calendar including the double championship race August 28/29 at Deer Park. Northwest Motor Sports has received a lot of positive feedback for this double event. Looks like a big weekend.

Northwest Region SCCA has informed Headquarters that they are cancelling the June 19/20 race at SIR.

A reminder that we have ICSCC Sponsor Passes, hats, patches, decals and badges for sale at each race. If you miss us, they can be requested by mail. Due to our agreement with SCCA, the Sponsor Pass allows admission to most SCCA races.

FROM THE RACE STEWARD, ED HOWELL

The 1982 ICSCC race season has begun, and the first IRDC race at SIR is history. The weather was at best unpredictable Saturday from heavy rain to gusty winds. Sunday, however, greeted racers to sunny skies and moderate temperatures.

IRDC should be commended for a great race. Except for a couple of incidents in the afternoon, everything was run on time.

Throughout the entire weekend there was only one case of passing under the yellow, something we can be proud of. The only way to top that is no incidents at all, which is our goal.

There was one major incident in Race Group 4, all production cars. No. 97cw got 2 wheels off the pavement attempting to pass two slower cars between turn 2b and 3a causing him to become airborne, which resulted in the car rolling over 1½ times coming to rest on its roof in the middle of the track. At the same time #48cw was exiting turn 2, upon seeing #97 on its top the driver of #48 took evasive action which resulted in a 180° spin and the car rolling completely over coming to rest on its wheels. Although there was very heavy vehicle damage the safety equipment did its job and both drivers were uninjured. This incident caused the race to be red

flagged. Prior to the red flag, two laps were run with all stations waving yellow flags. The speeds which most cars were going was not only unnecessary but unsafe. Be warned, we can not tolerate excessive speeds when under a yellow flag situation.

A note for production car drivers: this year Comp. Reg. 1402 C requires car weights to be determined by model year. At the next race please supply myself or Dave Adair, Asst. Race Steward, with a valid weight for your year and model car.

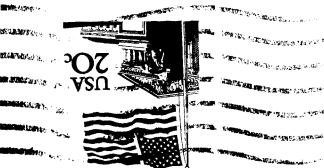
