DeeAnn Lensen takes over for Jeanine Bowl as the 2005 Banquet Facilitator. DeeAnn has previous experience with this position and did a fantastic job.

Jeanine now has an even bigger role to fill. For those who haven't heard, congratulations are in order for Jeanine and Chris on the arrival of their new baby boy, Ayden Michael Bowl. Ayden was born January 12th, jumping the green flag five weeks early. Both mom and baby are doing fine. The only remaining question is whether Ayden will be a closed wheel or open wheel racer?

2005 is the 49th year of the International Conference of Sports Car Clubs, which means next year will be our 50th Anniversary season. A 50th Anniversary Committee is being formed to come up with plans, ideas, logos, etc. to celebrate 50 years of racing and fun. It is with great sadness that we bid farewell to Bob Randall, friend and fellow racer, who left us December 11, 2004.

The ICSCC Driver of the Year trophy is called the Randall Cup in honour of Bob and his wife Hilda, who passed away earlier this year. These two individuals completely typified the Conference spirit and played a vital role in helping to make ICSCC the great organization it is today.

Our thoughts and prayers are with the Randall family.

The following is adapted from Bob's memoriam notice in the Vancouver Sun newspaper. and at the end is information on a planned Celebration of Life, to be held a Mission Raceway in May.

RANDALL - Robert Cheetham. It is with a deep sense of loss that we say 'farewell to a flier", Robert Cheetham Randall, our father, grandfather, and great-grandfather, passed away peacefully in his sleep on December 11th, 2004 at the age of 96 years, joining in heaven his life mate of 74 years, Hilda. Robert C. Randall or Bob as he was known to most, was born in Saskatoon, Saskatchewan on November 2, 1908. Bob spent his career as a pilot, earning his license in 1928. His flying accomplishments included mapping the western Yukon and eastern Alaska with Bradford Washburn's National Geographic Expedition in the 1930s, being the first to land on a glacier, and flying Canadian Pacific Airlines' newly developed international routes in the 1950s. He was one of the initial inductees to Canada's Aviation Hall of Fame. When he retired at the age of 60 he had logged over 31,000 hours as pilot in command! As well, Bob was actively involved in the Sports Car Club of BC and the International Conference of Sports Car Clubs, volunteering for over 40 years in many capacities including at the Indy Race in Vancouver. Bob leaves to mourn, his sister Edith, sons Bob Jr., Ted (Sharon), John (Pri), daughter Joan, fourteen grandchildren and thirteen great-grandchildren, many nieces, nephews and friends. Bob was predeceased by his wife Hilda, sisters, Florie and Phylis, brother Ted, and grandson Brian as well as Rick Kilburn. The family is grateful to the staff of The Waverly in Chilliwack for their care of both Bob and Hilda Randall in the last year. In lieu of flowers, donations may be made to the Heart and Stroke Foundation.
